

## Undergraduate Advising & Academic Support is **Now Hiring** **Academic Peer Coaches** for **Fall 2024**

### ***What is Academic Peer Coaching?***

Academic peer coaching focuses on Clark students' academic and professional concerns and perceived barriers to success. Coaches provide individual support and devise a personalized plan of action to develop skills such as time management, procrastination, test preparation, note taking, interview skills, and more.

### ***Who are Academic Peer Coaches?***

An Academic Peer Coach is an undergraduate engineering student who has a proven track record of success in the A. James Clark School of Engineering. Coaches are students who care about supporting their peers and understand that academic success is a complex process that requires various skills (e.g., time management, study skills, self-efficacy, etc.).

### **Qualifications:**

- 60 or more cumulative credits (Junior/Senior Standing)
- 3.3 cumulative GPA
- B- or higher in MATH141, PHYS161, and CHEM135
- Ability to manage time and work independently

### **Responsibilities:**

- Meet with student appointments every week to guide them through their academic and professional concerns (including student drop-in appointments)
- Make Action Plans to help students achieve their goals
- Help with program marketing efforts (i.e. emailing, tabling, making newsletters, etc.)
- Attend 1-hour biweekly meetings throughout the semester

### **Time Commitment:**

- Peer coaches will work 8 hours per week total (on Zoom and in-person) from **August 19, 2024 - December 9, 2024**
  - Coaches are expected to work in-person at least 2 hours on Wednesdays and Fridays
- Applicants should be available to work during the following dates:
  - Training & Coaching Orientation: August 19th - August 23rd
  - ClarkLEAD Transfer Welcome Event: August 23rd
- There is opportunity to continue this position beyond Fall 2024*

**Compensation:** \$2,000 stipend for the Fall 2024 semester
