

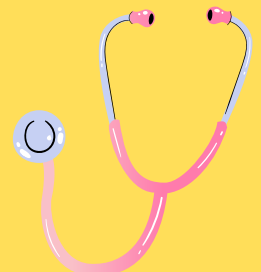
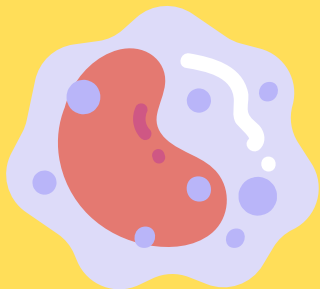

- The NSIP is a 10 week summer internship for undergraduate students integrating cancer research, education, and clinical experiences.
- >85% of our alumni are successful in matriculating to medical, graduate, and other professional degree programs.
- NSIP laboratory research and clinical shadowing are conducted at the University of Maryland Greenebaum Comprehensive Cancer Center located in Baltimore, MD.
- Interns receive a subsistence allowance of \$6000. Reduced cost campus housing and travel assistance are available.
